#### Tournament Conditions

1. The Pro-Am will be played over 54 holes and will be run according to R & A Rules of Golf, PGA Tournament Rules and Regulations - a copy of which will be posted on the tournament board and the local rules of Castletown Golf Links as supplied by the PGA. Professionals and amateur men will play from the white tees. Ladies will play from the L.G.U. tees.
2. The teams will consist of one professional and three amateurs.
3. Maximum Handicap: Men - 24 with  $\frac{3}{4}$  stroke allowance. Ladies - 30 with  $\frac{3}{4}$  stroke allowance plus 2 courtesy shots.

**Certificates verifying current amateur handicaps must be produced before the tournament starts.** PGA Officials will be available to check certificates. At the latest, certificates must be produced at check-in in the Speaker's Room by Hotel Reception before play in the first round.

4. All teams must ensure that they have checked-in at the Speaker's Room and are at their starting tee 10 minutes before their start time each day.
5. PRACTICE ROUNDS

The official practice day is Wednesday 21 June, starting times are available through Michael Brooks, PGA Professional, Telephone 01624 822211.

6. STARTING TIMES

The final draw for Starting Times for rounds 1 & 2 will be published on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> June 2006. Teams will generally be allocated one morning starting time (8.00 am to 10.00 am) and one afternoon starting time (12.45 pm to 2.45 pm) in advance for the first two rounds. If any teams have any specific requests please make sure they are forwarded to Sally Helwich by Monday 19<sup>th</sup> June 2006.

***Times for the final round (Saturday 24 June) will be allocated based on the Professional's score after two rounds with the leading players starting in the afternoon. NO REQUESTS FOR STARTING TIMES CAN BE ACCOMMODATED.***

7. The best net medal scores recorded by any two players in the team will count at each hole. The team with the lowest total over 54 holes will be the winners. In the event of ties for leading positions, final placings will be based on:-
- i) The lowest score in the final round and if still a tie
  - ii) The lowest score for holes 10-18 in the final round (irrespective of start tee) and if still a tie,
  - iii) The lowest score for holes 13-18 in the final round (irrespective of start tee) and if still a tie,
  - iv) The lowest score for holes 16-18 in the final round (irrespective of start tee) and if still a tie,
  - v) The lowest score for hole 18 in the final round (irrespective of start tee) and if still a tie,
  - vi) Sudden Death card play-off for final round starting at the 1st hole.

### 8. PROFESSIONAL PRIZEFUND

The professionals will also return individual scores for the professional prize money and ties will result in the prize money being shared. Total professional prizefund £20,000, the breakdown will be published on the tournament notice board.

### 9. AMATEUR PRIZES

Amateur prizes will be awarded as follows:-

- Top 5 teams overall.
- Leading 2 teams each day outside the top 6 overall.
- One Nearest the Pin and one Longest Drive each day.
- Scratch prize.

Please note: To be eligible for the overall prizes, team members must be unchanged over the three days. Teams who alter their personnel will only be eligible for day prizes.

### 9. PRESENTATION DINNER

The presentation dinner will take place in the Atholl Suite, Castletown Golf Links Hotel on Saturday 24 June. Arrival 8.00 pm for 8.30 pm. Dress Code – Jacket & Tie for gentlemen. All competitors are welcome.
